## Re: Congratulations on the 10th anniversary of the Health in All Policies Task Force

The World Health Organization (WHO) recognizes California's Health in All Policies Task Force on its 10<sup>th</sup> anniversary, for its invaluable contributions to this important and growing field.

The WHO 8th Global Conference on Health Promotion in Finland in 2013 resulted in the Helsinki Statement on Health in All Policies, defining it as an approach to public policies across sectors that systematically takes into account the health implications of decisions, seeks synergies, and avoids harmful health impacts. The approach emphasizes examining the consequences of public policies for health systems, and the determinants of health and equity. It builds upon a rich heritage of ideas and evidence that intersectoral action and healthy public policy are central elements for disease prevention and the realization of health as a human right.

Because of the great promise of the Health in All Policies approach, WHO supports its dissemination. It is recognized that governments have a range of priorities in which health and equity do not automatically gain precedence over other policy objectives. California's Health in All Policies Task Force has not only implemented cross-sectoral health equity practices, but also disseminated this approach at home and internationally through its collaboration with WHO and other initiatives.

On behalf of WHO, I extend our congratulations and appreciation to the many sectors represented on California's Health in All Policies Task Force for their dedication to advancing health equity, and to the staff and organizational partners, including the California Department of Public Health, Strategic Growth Council, and Public Health Institute, for their visionary leadership and commitment to collaboration.
